Installing your Device

Installing your GPS device is as easy as plugging in. The PNP-2000 is a non-diagnostic tracking device intended for light-duty vehicles ('95 or newer) with an OBD-II port.





Head over to the Portal to login with your credentials. The Portal requires Internet connection (DSL, broadband, or network connection recommended).


Meeting the Portal


