## Meeting the Portal – New & Classic


Once you have logged in with your credentials, the new Portal is displayed by default.


#### How to navigate:

Number	Feature	Description		
1	Мар	Click on a vehicle or landmark on the Map to open the associated information card (appears on the right-hand side of the screen).  Note. If any vehicles are unavailable due to unreliable data, an Unavailable button is displayed on the Map (to the left of the Map Panel). See Unavailable List below for additional information.		
1a	Map Panel	Use the Expand/Collapse button (on the right side of the Search Field) to expand or collapse the Map Controls Panel. The Map Control Panel includes the Search Field, Map Controls/View, and Vehicle/Landmarks List.		
2	Search Field	Type a search term in the box (vehicle ID, driver name, landmark, address/Point of Interest) to center the map over your query.		
3	Map Controls/View	Perform basic map tasks such as dropping a pin, sending a dispatch, and more and set your map view preferences (e.g., show/hide Points of Interest, landmarks, traffic, etc.).		
4	Vehicles/Landmarks List	View your vehicles, hierarchies, vehicles groups (as selected in the Data Source Selector), or Landmarks.		

### How to use the User Preferences page:

**Note.** The link to open the User Preferences page and the User Preferences page itself are only available to users with User Admin permission.

The User Preferences page allows you to set your Dashboard preferences for measurement unit (US (Standard) or Metric), time zone, default account landing page (Homepage, Map (New!), Map (Classic) or Classic Dashboard), and side-bar theme (dark or light). Additionally, you can logout from this page.
